Dear Friend:

We hope you are well. We write to ask for donations to cover a Deaf View/Image Art De'VIA curriculum kit that will be mailed to 10 Deaf schools in the US so that art teachers have materials and lesson plans to teach Deaf children about De'VIA. De'VIA is art about the Deaf experience and was established 25 years ago. Many of us have met Deaf folks who remark after learning about Deaf View / Image Art De'VIA: "I wish I had known about De'VIA when I was young." Deaf and Deaf-blind people readily identify with visual and tactile art about the Deaf experience. De'VIA affirms their sense of Deafhood while it gives visual testimony to the discrimination that Deaf People experience – making the invisible visible.

We are seeking donations to cover the \$5,000 needed for creating De'VIA curriculum kits. The kits will include:

- a very large high quality reproduction of the 2013 De'VIA mural which also serves as a teaching aid for motifs and themes
- a master coloring book and connect the dot book featuring important De'VIA art
- rubber mold,
- usb with curriculum, lesson plans, reproducible artworks and ASL videos
- and more

A finalized version of the De'VIA Curriculum and materials will be posted online, free to all. Funds will also be used to reimburse teachers and artists for travel to the curriculum development site, in cases where teachers and artists cannot get coverage from their schools and to cover food expenses. Lodging for the Fall East coast curriculum development working group was kindly provided by the Rochester School for the Deaf. Plans are under way for a 2nd curriculum working group on the West coast for this summer. All the teachers and artists are donating their time, expertise, and art to this cause.
