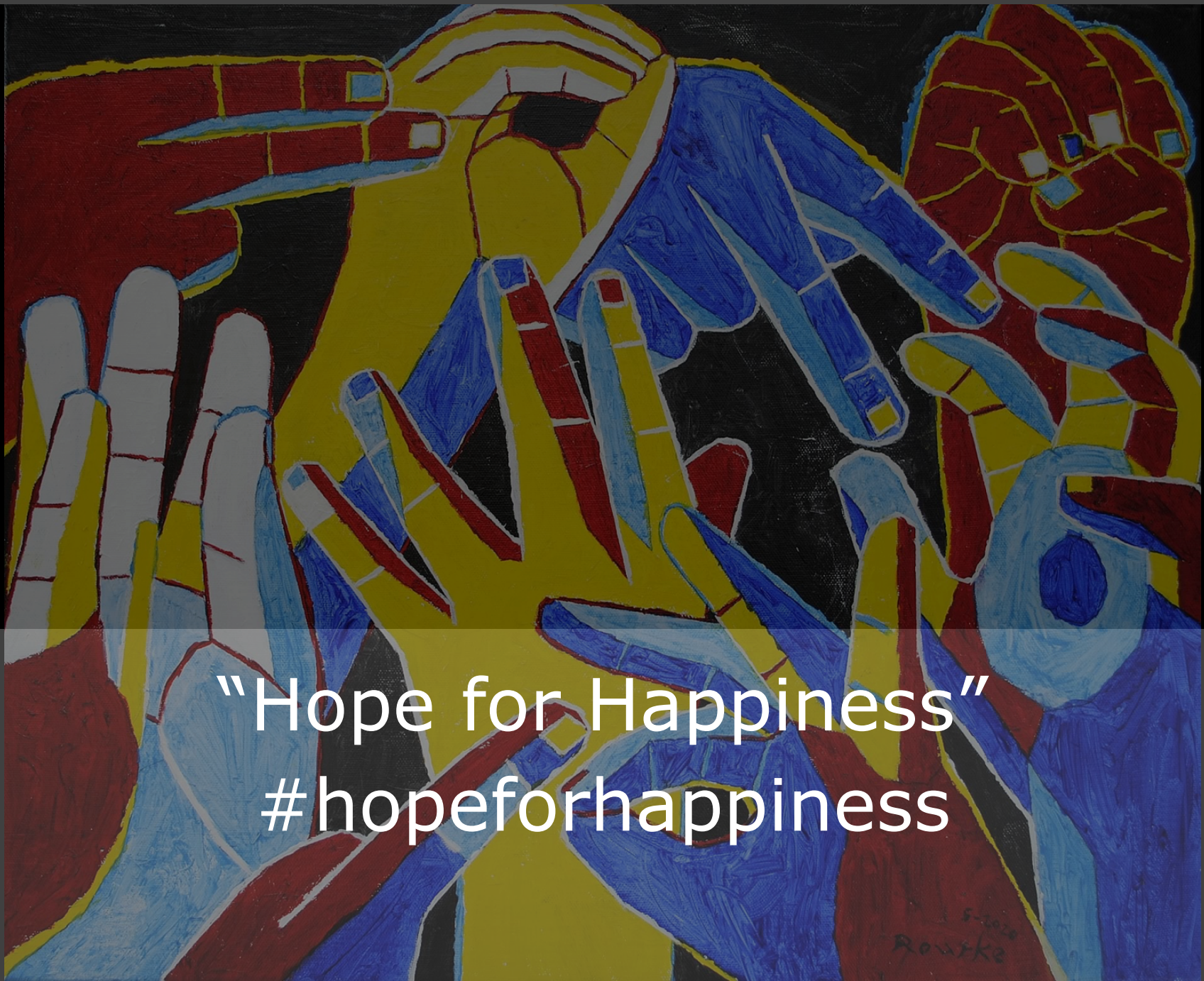

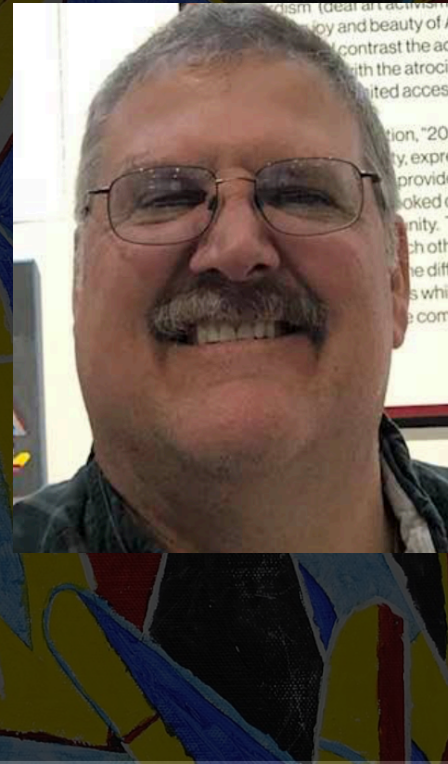

Supplies you will need:

16 inch by 20 inch canvas

red, yellow, blue, black and white acrylic paints

small, medium and large nylon paintbrushes

masking tape and scotch tape

red ballpoint pen

8.5 inch by 11 inch carbon paper or

graphite transfer paper

container for water

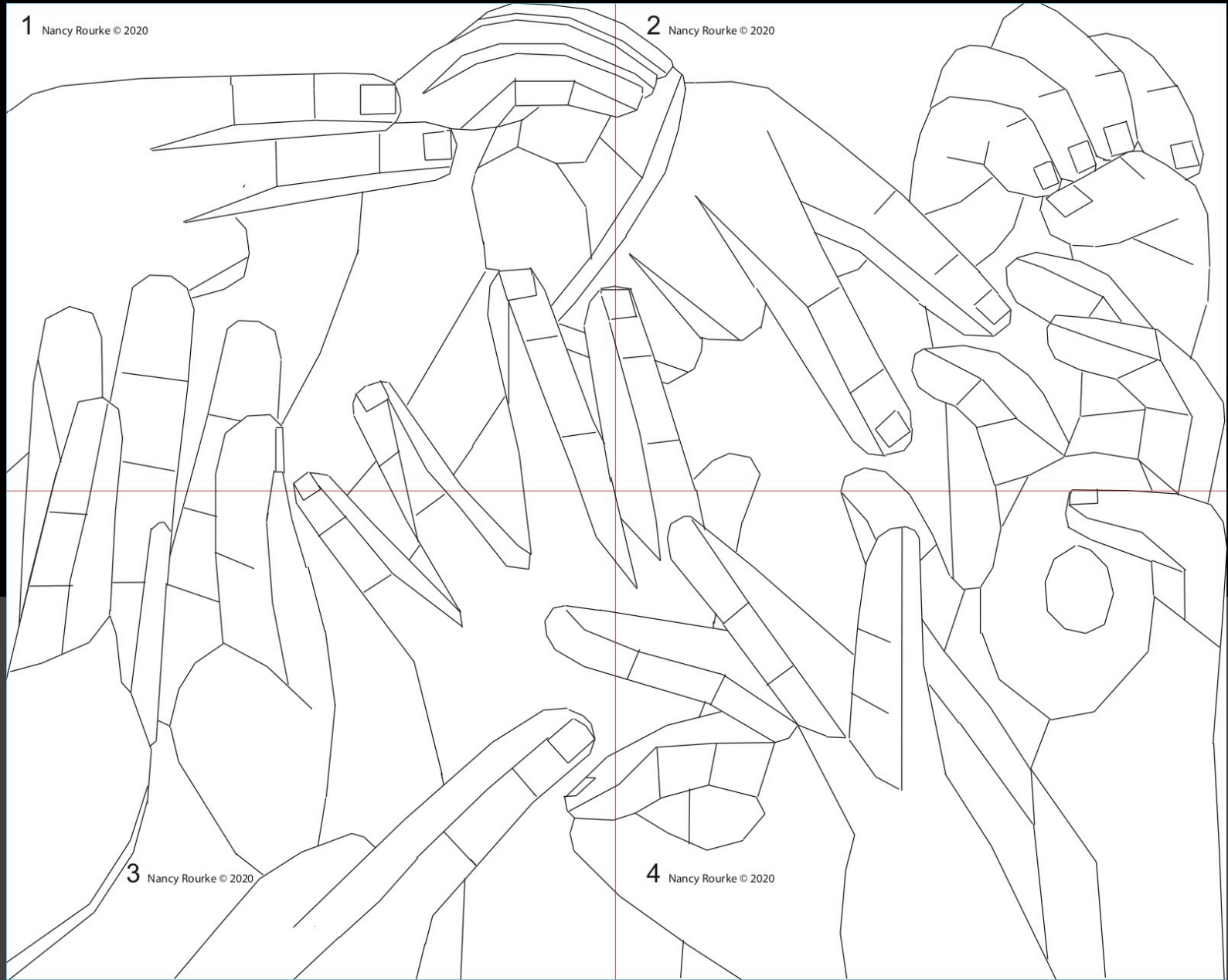
paper towel

plate for paint

spoon to mix colour

table easel (optional)

Four prints. at 100% scale. Print in colour.



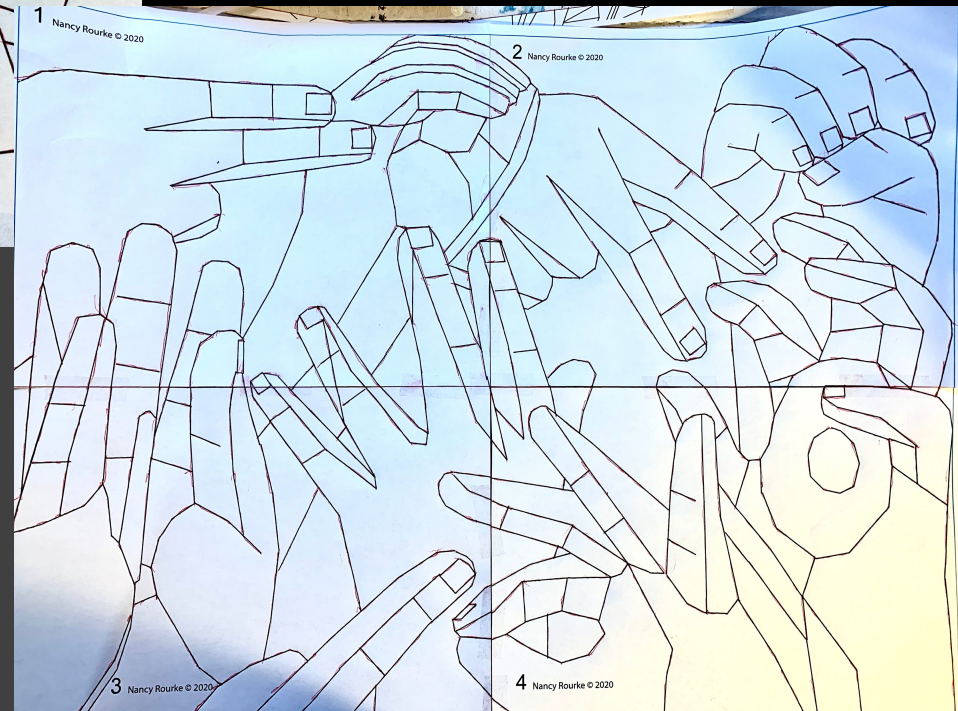
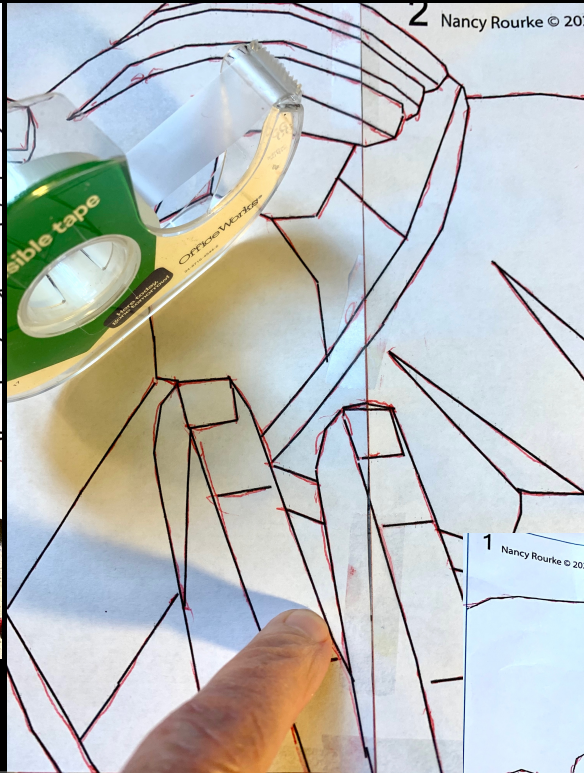

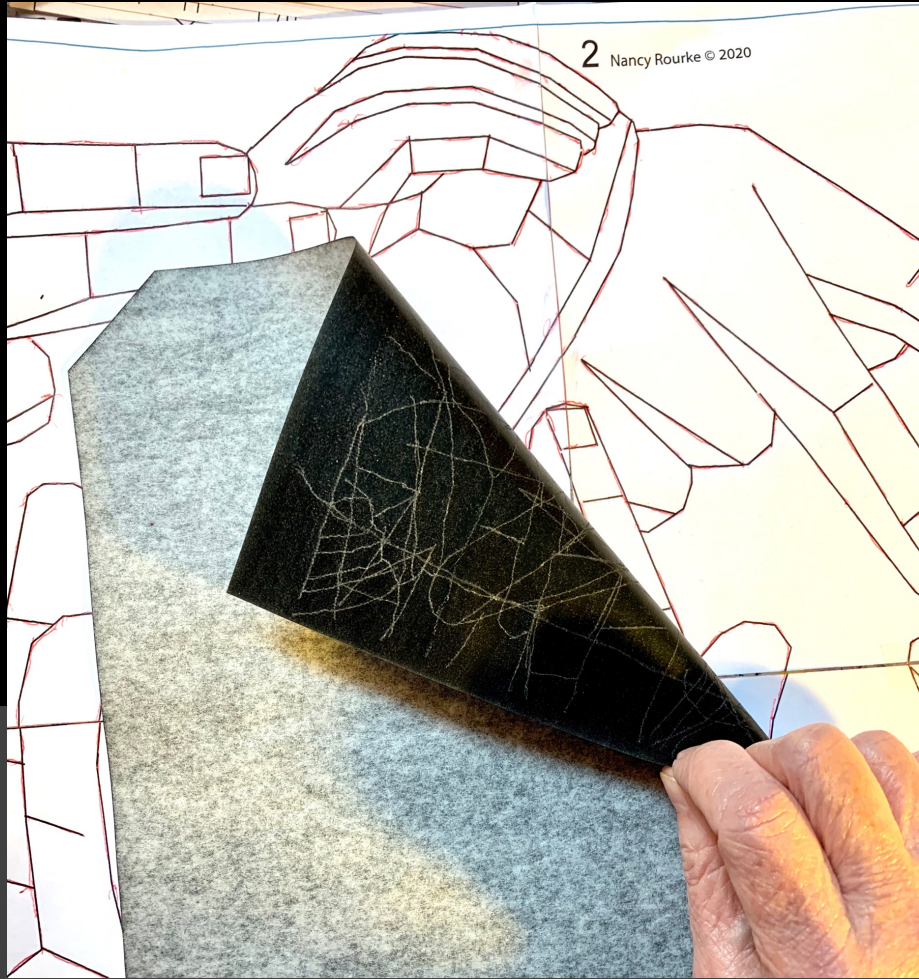

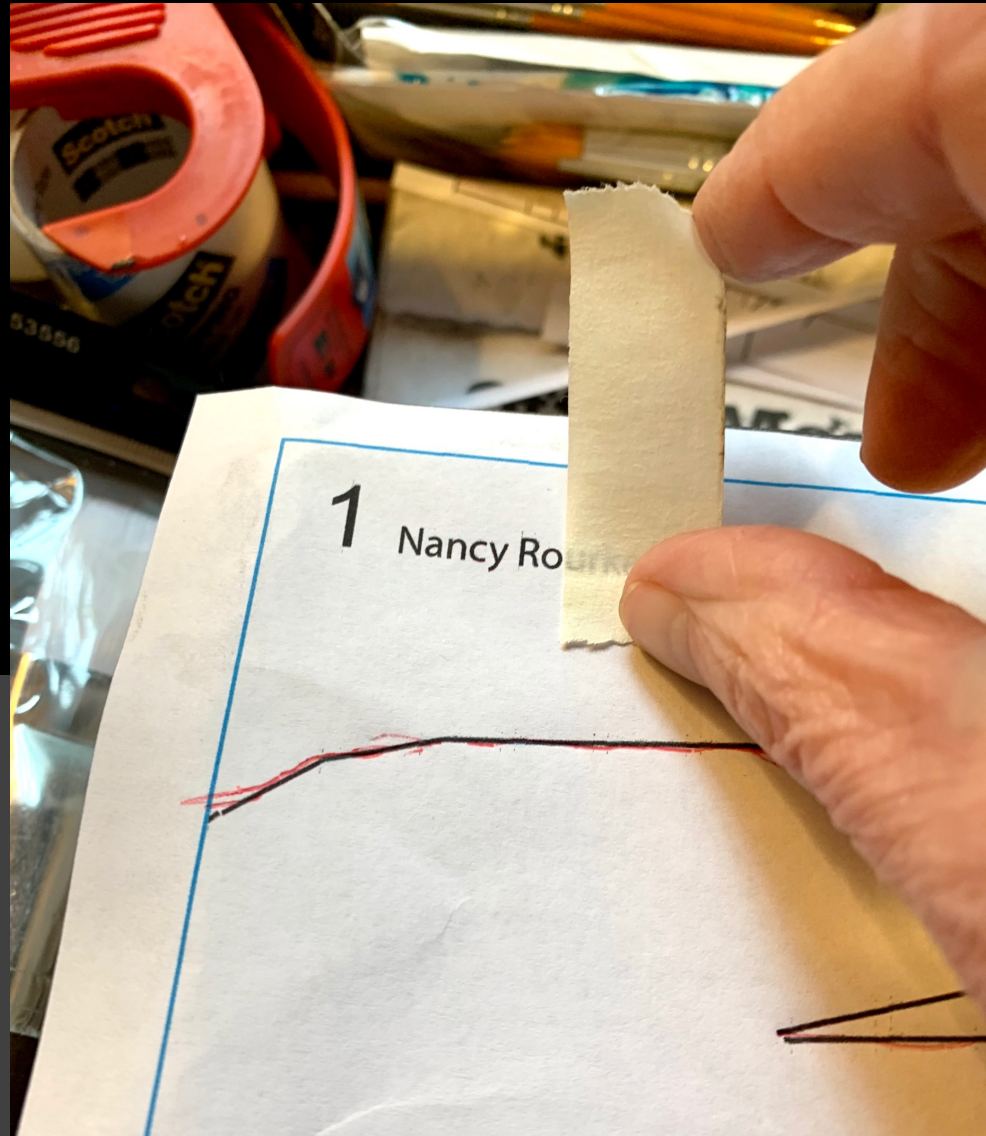
Cut out red lines and tape together four prints



One carbon paper or you can colour with black crayon or pencil on the back of print.



Blue lines meet at the corner of the canvas.
Use a masking tape and tape it over the canvas.



You will need to mix white and blue to
make light blue.

Blue

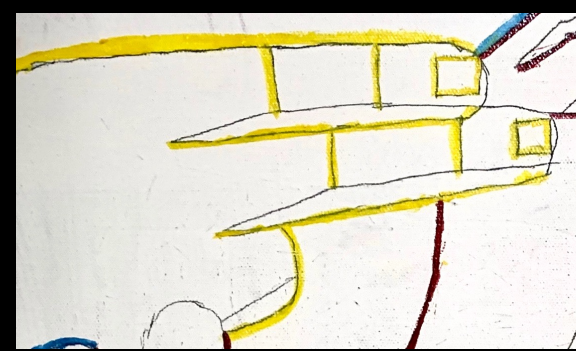
Black

Start with a small paintbrush. Paint the lines around the hands first with yellow, red, light blue and blue.

→Paint the WHITE lines at the very end←

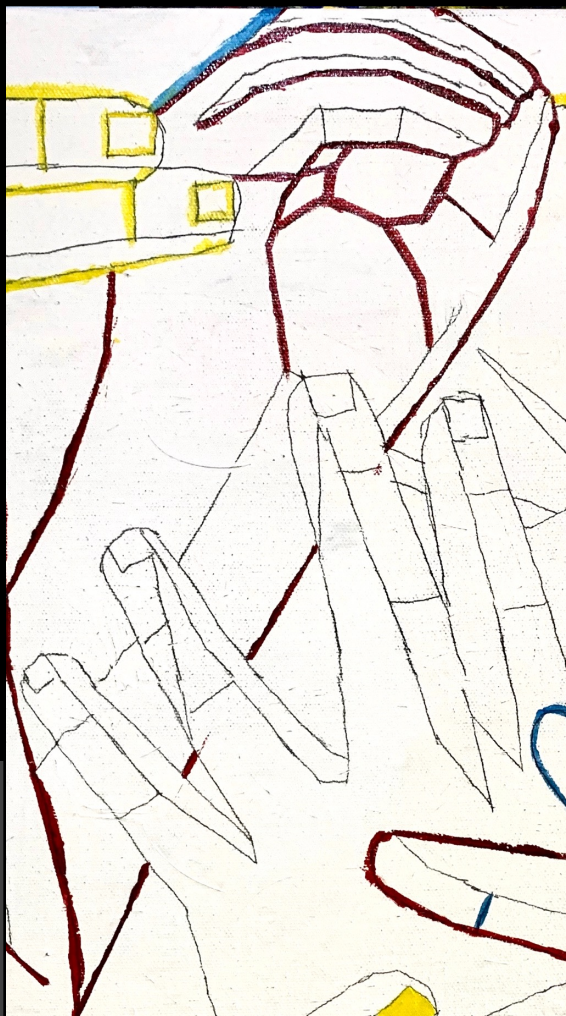


H hand close-up

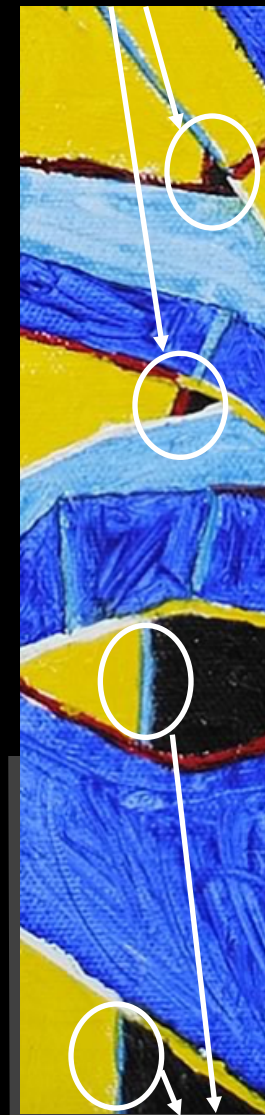

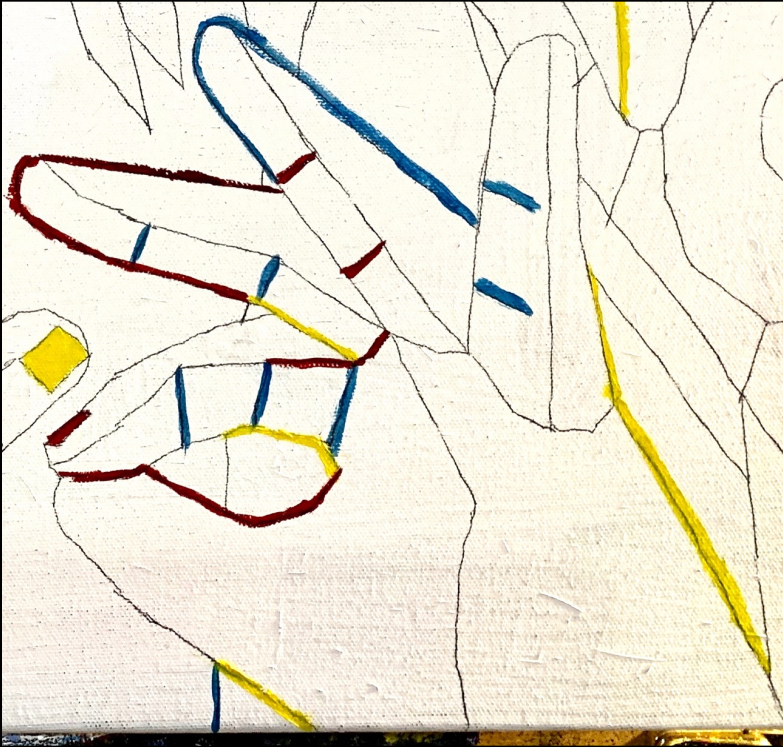

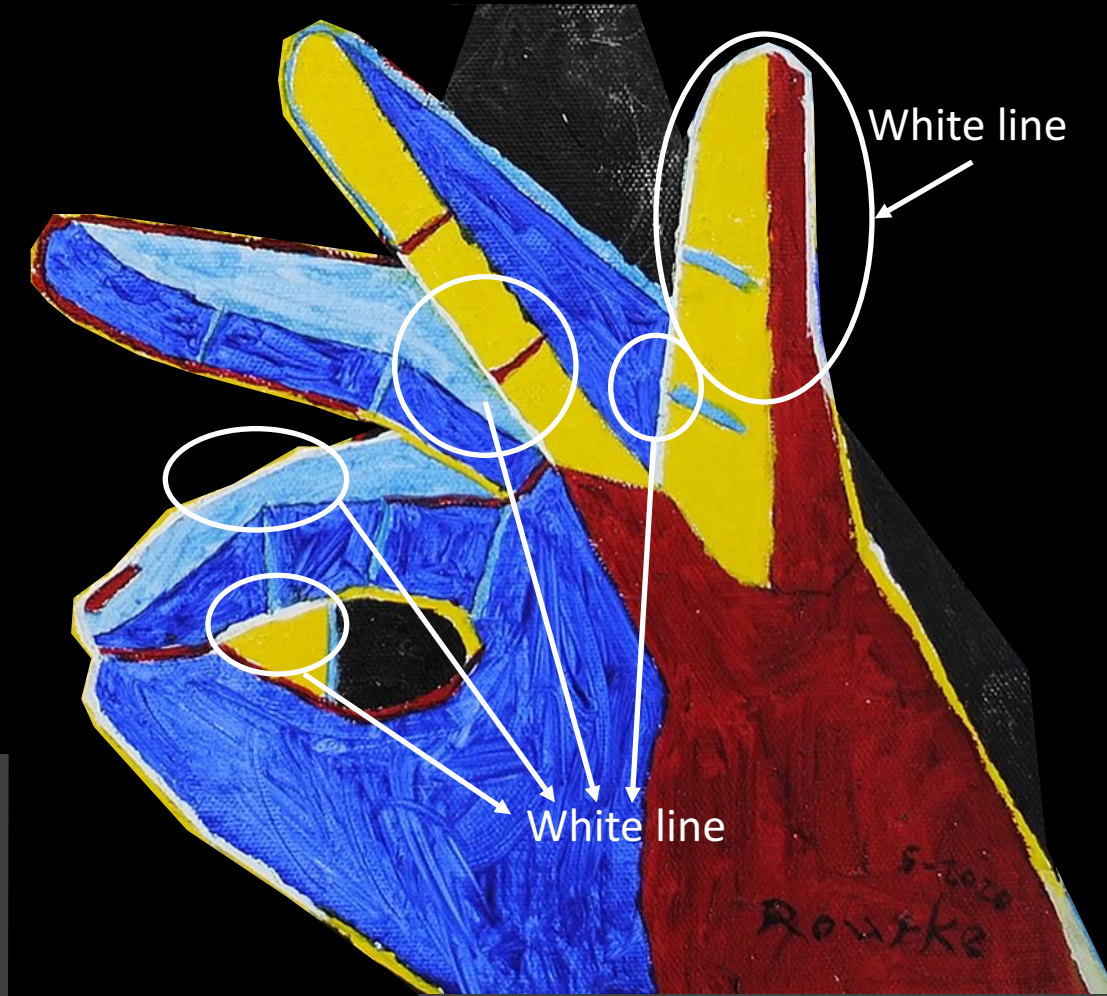
LINES- white at the very end, light blue and red

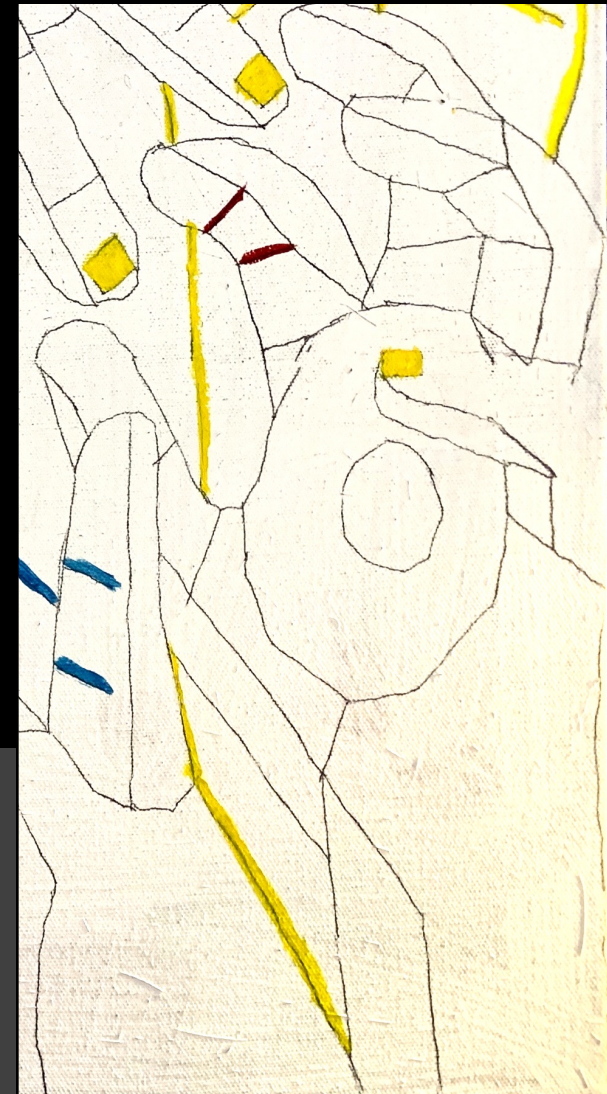
