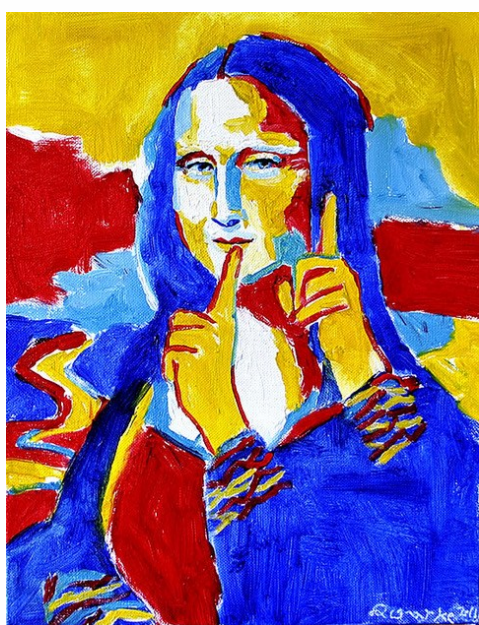


The College of Western Idaho **Visiting Artist Series** welcomes
